You will not have to adjust to our Ethos curriculum.

Note: Your College Lecture and Arts Events are easily mapped into our College Enrichment Events. Your requirement of three (3) events per semester, as it is part of your Explorations curriculum.

- <u>Complete your current major.</u>
  - In degree programs that LaGrange offers, we will ensure that you can graduate with the major you chose and the requirements you have been taking at BSC. If there are additional requirements you still need to complete for your BSC major when you arrive on our campus, we will identify similar coursework at LaGrange for you to complete. You will not complete requirements beyond what you needed to take at BSC.
- Waive departmental or disciplinary requirements beyond major completion.
   Any additional disciplinary requirements beyond completion of the Explorations curriculum and major will be waived.
