Included in the SGA EC are "Director" positions that will be selected by the elected EC based on application and interviews. The following Director positions are open for the 2017-2018 academic year: (a) Director of Service; (b) Director of Programming & Public Relations; (c) Director of Sustainability & the Food Committee. Each Director position will chair a committee of student volunteers.

Requirements for Running

Students seeking the office of **President** must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Been in SGA for at least one year
- ✓ Be a junior or senior in the year they serve
- ✓ Maintain a cumulative 2.6 GPA
- ✓ Be enrolled at LC at least one full semester prior to running

Students seeking the office of any **Vice President** position must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Be a junior or senior in the year they serve OR been in SGA for one year
- ✓ Maintain a cumulative 2.6 GPA
- ✓ Be enrolled at LC at least one full semester prior to running

Students seeking any **other SGA EC positions** must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Be a sophomore, junior, or senior in the year they serve
- ✓ Maintain a cumulative 2.6 GPA
- ✓ Be enrolled at LC at least one full semester prior to running

Elected SGA officers are encouraged to seek work study with the Office of the Dean of Students. It is the responsibility of each student to communicate with the financial aid office to determine eligibility and submit appropriate paperwork.
