The specialist degree in Curriculum and Instruction offers a comprehensive examination of the field of curriculum designed to develop the theoretical knowledge competencies and strategies needed by teachers and other curriculum developers at all levels of education to participate in the curriculum change process. Coursework provides the foundation to explore how the relationship between policy and curriculum affect instructional planning, design and evaluation decisions. The Initial Certification is for those candidates who have a M.Ed. in another area.

- Candidates choosing the Embedded Tier I program may begin in the spring.
