Tier I Educational Leadership certification is a self-select option for certified teachers who seek leadership positions in schools below the principal and district level. Tier I leadership certification prepares the educational leader with research-based knowledge, skills and dispositions necessary to make positive changes in schools and increase student learning. Those seeking Tier I certification may complete these requirements while enrolled in the M.Ed. / Ed.S. programs or independently as an add-on to an existing graduate degree.
