

Delve into the country's rich culture and visit iconic landmarks like Sintra, Fatima and Tomar. Whether you're into history, culinary experiences or relaxation, Portugal's diverse offerings make it an ideal destination for a memorable European journey.

## ITINERARY

### DAY 1, Monday, March 18 OVERNIGHT FLIGHT

### DAY 2, Tuesday, March 19 LISBON

Arrive in Lisbon. Meet your travel director and transfer to your hotel in central Lisbon. Welcome dinner.

### DAY 3, Wednesday, March 20 LISBON

Enjoy a sightseeing tour with a local guide showing you highlights such as the Monument of the Discoveries, Alfama district, Rossio Square and St. George's Castle. Included is an inside visit to the Jerónimos Monastery. Free afternoon.

### DAY 4, Thursday, March 21 LISBON

Today visit the hillside town of Sintra and the

colorful Palacio Nacional da Pena, which was the summer residence of Portuguese kings and is famed for its tile work. Then visit the seaside town of Estoril before returning to Lisbon. In the evening enjoy a fado show with dinner.

### DAY 5, Friday, March 22 LISBON

Today is a free day. Your travel director will make recommendations. Possible visits/activities include the National Tile Museum, the Gulbenkian Museum, the National Museum of Ancient Art, cooking lesson and strolling around Rossio – the heart of the city.

### DAY 6, Saturday, March 23 TOMAR AREA

This morning drive north with stops in the beautiful towns of Obidos, Nazaré, Alcobaça and Fátima – where three shepherd children

reported apparitions of the Virgin Mary in 1917. Dinner and overnight in the Tomar area.

**DAY 7, Sunday, March 24**  
**TOMAR AREA**

Enjoy a guided visit of Tomar with a local expert including a visit to the Convent of Christ – originally built as a Templar stronghold in the 12th century. Free afternoon.

**DAY 8, Monday, March 25**  
**PORTO**

This morning drive to Coimbra for a guided visit of this beautiful university town. Continue to Aveiro where you will enjoy a canal boat ride. Dinner and overnight in Porto.

**DAY 9, Tuesday, March 26**  
**PORTO**

This morning enjoy a sightseeing tour of Porto. You will see the baroque churches, cobblestone

lanes around the Douro River, remarkable bridges that span the river and the Gothic Church of St. Francis. See the Stock Exchange Palace with its Arabian Hall inspired by the Alhambra. Free afternoon to spend strolling through the historic center of the city.

**DAY 10, Wednesday, March 27**  
**PORTO**

Enjoy a boat cruise on Douro River with visit to a local Port Quinta for wine tasting and lunch.

**Day 11, Thursday, March 28**  
**LISBON**

Drive back to Lisbon. Free afternoon and farewell dinner.

**DAY 12, Friday, March 29**  
**Transfer to Lisbon airport for return flight to USA**
