## What exactly is **urgent care**?

Urgent care includes treatment for such things as upper respiratory infection, cough, earache, urinary tract infections, flu symptoms, fever, sprains/strains, conjunctivitis (pink eye), nausea and vomiting. Chronic conditions such as high blood pressure, attention deficit disorder, diabetes, high cholesterol are not included.

## Are my **visits** shared with anyone?

No. All health information within the clinic remains confidential. No personal health information (PHI) is shared with your school in any way.
