

O-TEAM MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS Overview Document 2018-2019

Brief Description

Membership on the LaGrange College Orientation Team (O-Team) has long been considered one of the institution's most prized student leadership positions. O-Team members represent the College and welcome incoming students as well as their families to campus during summer orientation sessions and First Week. The O-Team sets the tone for how all incoming students start their college experience! Namely, O-Team members must be available to set up facilities, greet incoming students, mentor individual O-Team student groups, assist with course registration, attend workshops, and be available for questions at all times during orientations and First Week. Likewise, in the coming year, the College will be asking O-Team members to follow up with individual students upon request during the academic year – this individualized outreach will be the core of a new retention strategy being implemented by the school. We are looking for individuals who love the institution and have the time, energy, and dedication to serve our incoming students.

Requirements

- Cumulative GPA and most recent semester GPA of 2.6
- Be a student in good standing and registered for 2018 Fall semester classes
- Permit the College permission to review any institutional disciplinary records that may exist.
- Be available to work at least two orientation sessions and all of First Week (unless written permission is provided by the Dean of Students) this includes excluding yourself from all work-related duties and spending the entire days working on O-Team tasks . . .
 - Orientation Session I: June 6 (evening), June 7 (all day), & June 8 (until noon)
 - Orientation Session II: June 13 (evening), June 14 (all day), & June 15 (until noon)
 - Orientation Session III: July 11 (evening), July 12 (all day), & July 13 (until noon)
 - Orientation Session IV: August TBA
 - First Week: August 24 (evening) August 28
- Your assistance with Transfer Orientation may also be requested, especially if you are a transfer student to LaGrange College. These dates are:
 - Transfer Orientation Session I: July TBA
 - Transfer Orientation Session II: August TBA
- Be able to attend our O Team Group Interview
 - Sunday, March 11 (2pm 5pm)
- Be able to attend 2 mandatory weekend trainings
 - Sunday, March 18 (2pm 5pm)
 - Sunday, April 15 (2pm 5pm)
- Be available for specialized training on targeted retention outreach in the Fall and be open to meeting with individual students throughout the academic year upon request of the College as part of the institution's student retention efforts

How to Apply

- Complete the 2018 O-Team Application and attach required essay.
- Get the O-Team Recommendation Form completed and signed by either your Cornerstone instructor or your current advisor.
- Print and submit the application to the appropriately labeled box in Smith Hall, Room 124 (you may include the recommendation form if it is given back to you).
 - O Due by 5 pm on Wednesday, March 7th.
- When you submit your application, sign up for an interview time. Interviews will be conducted March 12th 15th.
- You are also required to attend a group interview session on Sunday, March 11th 2pm 5pm.
 - o Casual dress is fine with the group interview.
- Arrive promptly for your interview (business casual attire suggested).
